- 3) the clergy assignments (Administrator, Parochial Vicar, Deacon and Parish Chaplain),
- 4) the number of Sunday Masses for the grouping, and
- 5) the blueprint for the grouping.

The effective date of the new groupings and clergy assignments is October 15, 2018. From April 26, 2018 till October 15, 2018 the out-going and incoming clergy will work setting the Mass schedule for all parishes in the new grouping, as well as, beginning to look at programs as staffing in the new grouping.

## Classroom Spotlights

### 3rd and 4th grade

McDonald's Restaurant and its supplier, Keystone Foods, visited the 3rd and 4th grade classes to give their "Econ and You" class presentation.

The economics lesson focused on a discussion of the resources that are involved in hamburger production: natural resources (cows), capital

resources (warehouse equipment), and human resources

(people.) Students watched a video taken at the largest

processing plant to demonstrate how the meat is received, made into patties, and then shipped to restaurants while highlighting all of the steps that must be taken to keep the food safe.

Each class was challenged to calculate how many hamburgers are produced each day at this largest processing facility by solving a series of multiplication problems: the answer-5,180,400 per day!

Each student received a certificate for a free cheeseburger at our neighborhood McDonald's on Route 60, which sponsored the presentation.



## Cross Country

### Slippery Rock Invitational and Diocesan Championship

On successive weekends, the Holy Trinity School cross country team competed at the Cooper's Lake course in Slippery Rock. On October 14, at the Slippery Rock Invitational, three individual JV runners medaled: Mia Crofford for placing 16th and McKinley Walsh for placing 21st out of 171 girls, and Luke Baker for finishing 17th out of 149 boys. There were over 1400 runners that competed in this meet from both public and private schools. Congratulations to all those who participated!



On October 21, at the Diocesan Championship, the JV girls team finished in 3rd place and the Varsity boys finished in 5th place to conclude the season. This is the first time that the school had two teams medal at the Diocesan Championship!



In addition, three individual JV girls medaled at the Diocesan Championship. Individual medalists were Mia Crofford (15th), Sophia Saginaw (16th) and Joelle Ludwick (17th) out of 207 girls.

Coach Roberts noted that he was extremely proud of the effort by the entire team. Congratulations runners!
