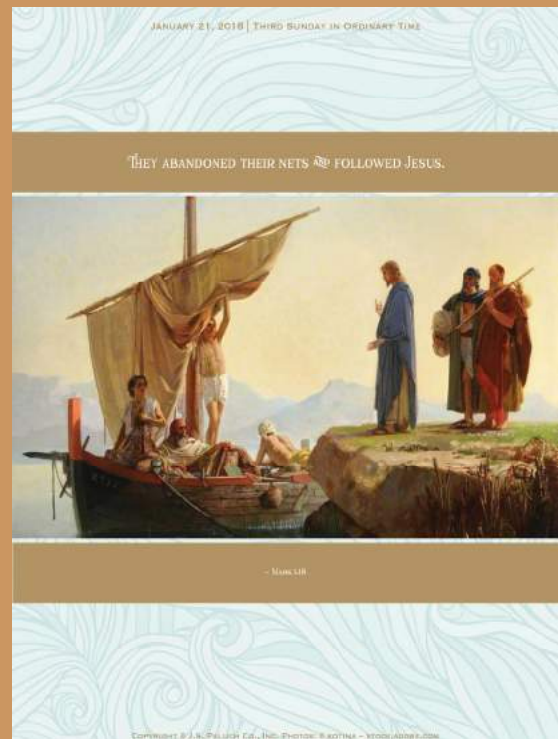

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

* Candidates and Sponsors are requested to submit the following documents this time:

Candidates: Baptism and First Communion certificates; not required if the candidate was baptized at Holy Trinity.

Sponsors: Letter of Eligibility, to be a sponsor, from the parish in which she or he is registered; not required if the sponsor is a member of Holy Trinity.

Qualifications to be a Sponsor:

- * Fully initiated into the church; Baptized, received First Communion, and Confirmed.
- * Over the age of sixteen.
- * A member in good standing in their parish as verified by a "Letter of Eligibility" to be a sponsor.
- * Attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.
- * Receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist.
- * If married, the marriage was to have taken place in the Catholic Church and living in a valid marriage.

Note

- * The sponsor does not have to be the same gender as the candidate.
- * Parents may not be sponsors; other family members who meet the qualifications may be sponsors.
- * The sponsor should meet frequently with the candidate expressing their intention to accept this role.

A **Godparent** from Baptism is an excellent choice for a sponsor.
